DIRECTIONS TO TEN31 Productions:

We are located at 249 Roosevelt Avenue in Pawtucket, but can be a little difficult to find. The directions below will help you find our home, tucked up behind the building beside the Blackstone River.

From 95N (Providence)

Take **EXIT 29** Bear **LEFT** on Ramp toward **Broadway** Turn **LEFT** onto **Broadway**/US-1 At the first light,Turn **RIGHT** onto **Exchange St.** At the first light, turn **RIGHT** onto **Roosevelt Ave.**

From 95S (Boston)

Take EXIT 29 Turn RIGHT onto Fountain Street Turn RIGHT onto Exchange St. At the first light, turn RIGHT onto Roosevelt Ave.

Once you've found entrance to 249 Roosevelt Avenue's parking lot: follow the river behind the building, back and to the left, and we're just down the way.
