Medicine was young, and the medical profession was rife with pedantic peddlers of false remedies to misunderstood ailments that were often more dangerous than the diseases themselves; **Doctors were, in short, quacks**. They could promise doom and then engender the hope of salvation by presenting the only solution to the problem they created in the first place.

"But this play is not about the fools, the liars, the doctors, but about those of us who believe their lies at the expense of those nearest us, and how if we overcome our feelings, put our faith instead in those who truly have our best interests at heart, and employ reason, the truth will out. Moliere's comedy is of his most hysterical and most poignant to a modern audience."
